The Inspiration for Ultra Care for Cancer **Caregivers**

In 2018 my husband Jon was diagnosed with stage 4 cancer. Our lives were turned upside down. Jon endured cancer pain, weight loss, chemotherapy, aggressive radiation, and four surgeries. Today Jon is in remission. We are grateful. He had top oncologists, surgeons, tumor board, and amazing oncology nurses.

Caregivers play a big role in the care of the emotional and spiritual life of cancer patients. While trying to keep it together and falling apart, caregivers are often forgotten by friends and family. To cope and stay mentally and physically healthy, I ran ultramarathons. This was my respite. I also joined a well spouse support group. I knitted scarves for cancer caregivers.

A 2018 ASCO (American Society of Clinical Oncology) report shows that the number of cancer caregivers in the U.S. ranges from a startling 2.8 to 6.1 million, with caregivers providing an average of almost 33 hours a week of care for their loved ones tackling cancer, whether they be friends or family.
